



AMERICAN PETROLEUM'S DRIVER SAFETY STANDARDS

Our delivery team and drivers count with all of the safety certifications required to handle hazardous materials and respond properly to any emergency. They have received all of the necessary training to guarantee efficient and safe deliveries.

American Petroleum personnel is trained to:

- **Identify transportation risks of gasoline and diesel.**
- **Create a secure perimeter in case of any spill or emergency.**
- **Manage any situation that could affect the environmental or occupational health (Level D)** - They are equipped with absorbent material for petroleum derivate management and emergency equipment such as cones, reflectors, flags, lights, among others.
- **Manage the Transportation of Hazardous materials** based on a certification granted after an 8 hour training (which is renewed every two years).

Additionally, the personnel in the workshop and warehouse are trained to properly manage fork lifts, which is required by OSHA and renewed every 3 years.

For added safety, all delivery staff has personal protection class D that implies a safety vest, safety boots, and gloves. In case it is needed, they also count with helmet and glasses.
